***2019 Call for Entries:
Excellence in Concrete
Construction Awards***

PURPOSE:

To recognize creative, innovative, aesthetic or simply important uses of concrete in Virginia construction.

AWARDS:

The top project may be recognized in each of 6 categories. In addition, the overall **Commonwealth Award** will be presented to the single project which epitomizes the most unique and effective use of concrete. Up to three Virginia Projects may be eligible to compete at the **ACI International** level.

AWARD CATEGORIES:

-**Low Rise Buildings**, up to three stories

-**Mid-Rise Buildings**, four to 15 stories

-**High-Rise Buildings**, more than 15 stories

-**Infrastructure**-bridges, site structures, water resources structures, marine structures, other transportation structures

-**Decorative Concrete** –exterior and interior finishes, ornamentation, hardscapes, flatwork

-**Repair and Restoration**

ELIGIBILITY:

- Project must be essentially completed during the 2019 calendar year.
- Shall have a substantial quantity of concrete or incorporate significant architectural, technical or sustainable concepts.
- Project must be located within the Commonwealth of Virginia (excluding the counties of Arlington, Fairfax, Loudon and Prince William which are in the National Capitol Chapter region).

SUBMITTAL:

Submit ALL of the following electronically:

1. The project submittal form.
2. A maximum one-page description of how concrete was featured in the project. Other suggested topics are the

complexity and uniqueness of the project, special features, degree of difficulty, challenges, environmental factors, and problem solving.

3. A minimum of 4 and maximum of 8 color photographs highlighting the project. A 90-second time-lapse video (not animated) may be submitted in lieu of one of the required photos.

The submittal can be emailed or made on CD or thumb drive media. Submitted media will not be returned.

The awards committee will review the submitted materials and will select the winners based on:

- Architectural and engineering merit**
- Creativity**
- Innovative construction techniques, solutions and use of materials**
- Ingenuity**
- Sustainability and resilience**
- Functionality and end use suitability**

The winners will be notified of the committee's decision. The awards will be recognized at the **2020 Virginia Concrete Conference** held on Thursday Feb. 27, 2020.
